However, any funeral arrangement you choose will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide, describing the funeral goods and services selected.

“Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party of the decedent’s survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any pre-need agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.”

Professional Services of Funeral Director & Staff

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains, other package prices. This fee includes: arrangement conference; preparation of the death certificate; 24-hour on call; preparation of permit; coordination of cemetery and/or crematory services; common carrier arrangements; clergy arrangement; notification to social security; clerical and administrative duties; coordination of outside services; a portion of this fee is used for Staff, building, licenses, taxes, utilities, overhead\$1995

Embalming

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as funeral with no viewing or presentation of the body\$595

Basic Services

Forwarding of Remains

This includes removal of remains, basic services of staff, necessary authorization, embalming, use of preparation room, and transportation to airport (excluding shipping charges and container). This charge does not include use of the facilities and staff for visitation or ceremonies. This charge applies to shipment within the continental United States\$1895

Receiving Remains

This includes basic services of staff, transportation from airport in van, transportation of remains in utility vehicle to local cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include any other merchandise, cash advances, visitation or ceremonies.....\$1895

Immediate Burial

This service includes the following, Basic services of the Funeral Director: local transfer of the remains to the funeral home within our service area: sheltering and refrigeration of the remains, use of morgue for basic staff care of the deceased, alternative vehicle for delivery of the body to the grave. This does not include, viewing, visitation, ceremony, or other use of facilities or any merchandise\$1750

viewing, visitation or funeral ceremony. You may furnish an alternative cremation container, which must encase the body and be made of materials such as wood, fiberboard or composition materials (with or without covering).
